Recreational Pilot Permit

In August of 1995, Transport Canada created a new type of flight training called the *Recreational Pilot Permit*. Although it is relatively restrictive, it is an opportunity for people to learn to fly for about half the cost of a Private Pilot Licence - and all hours will count towards the Private Pilot Licence if you wish to attain that at a later date.

Requirements:

Minimum Age:	14 (Student Pilot Permit) 16 (Recreational Pilot Permit)
Medical:	Category 4,3 or 1
Flight Training:	25 hours, including at least: - 15 hours dual (with minimum of 2 hours cross-country) - 5 hours solo
Ground School:	40 hours minimum - recommended
Examinations:	- Student Pilot Written Exam (PSTAR) - Radio Operators Exam (Industry Canada) - MOT Written Exam (RPPAE or PPAER) - MOT Flight Test - Aviation Language Proficiency Test (ALPT)

Privileges:

The holder of a Recreational Pilot Permit may, **in daytime visual flying conditions**, act as Pilot-in-Command in:

- single-engine, single pilot, non-high-performance airplanes of a class and type as endorsed on the licence
- an aircraft designed to carry a maximum of 4 persons, **although**, no more than **one** passenger be carried on board
- an ultra-light airplane
- Canada only

Skill:

Within 12 months preceding date of application for permit, the applicant shall successfully complete a flight test to Standards as outlined in "Flight Test Standards Recreational Pilot Permit" TP 12475E.

Knowledge:

The student must pass, with 60%, each of the following mandatory areas as well as overall written examinations RPPAE or PPAER:

- Air Law
- Navigation
- Meteorology
- General Knowledge
